

Postdoctoral Fellowships at INED – 12 months potentially renewed

The French National Institute for Demographic Studies (Institut National d'Etudes Démographiques, INED) offers a post-doctoral position for one young researcher working in the area of population analysis. The post-doctoral student will receive a grant from the French Ministry of Research of approx.1800 Euros monthly net amount.

Young researcher having defended his/her PhD thesis within the last 5 years with a background in demography, economics, sociology, history, anthropology, epidemiology, etc. are encouraged to apply before the **15th of January 2011**.

The recruited person will work under the supervision of one INED researcher and participate in the activities of one research unit. The list of research units is available at the following address: http://www.ined.fr/en/current_researchs/units/. International collaboration will also be encouraged.

Procedure :

1/ Candidates are encouraged to contact their potential advisor and the research units that may welcome their applications.

2/ Candidates are expected to submit a 2-3 research project, agreed with their advisor.

3/ The application should include :

- The research proposal (2-3 pages maximum).
- One motivation letter.
- A complete CV, including the complete list of publications and works.
- The PhD thesis including the defense report.
- One publication (paper, book chapter) seen as the most significant achieved work.
- Two supportive letters : one by a senior researcher chosen by the applicant outside of INED; one from the expected advisor at INED.

The recruitment may start effectively within the first semester 2011. Interviews of a pre-selected panel of candidates may occur through video-conference.
