

Stockholm University invites applications for: PhD student position in Sociological Demography

The Department of Sociology at Stockholm University announces a PhD study position in Sociological Demography. The position is located at the department's Demography Unit (SUDA).

Requirements

To be qualified for doctoral studies in Sociological Demography you need to have:

- An advanced level academic degree (magister/master) or
240 completed ECTS credits, including at least 60 credits at the advanced level;
- Performed independent research in demography or a related discipline, as proven by thesis or other written work,
- Enough English language proficiency to profit by the teaching.

In section 2 of the Syllabus for doctoral studies in Sociological Demography (www.suda.su.se/courses_sub_doctoral.asp) you find the requirements described in more detail, together with conditions for students who in 2007-06-30 were qualified according to former regulations.

Selection criteria

The selection among applicants is based on the assessment of the ability to successfully complete the doctoral studies in Sociological Demography. Special attention is devoted to:

- the quality of the candidate's earlier writing and other merits,
- originality, feasibility, and potential contribution to the sociological demography of the planned research,
- possibilities for the department to offer adequate supervision of the planned research,
- documented competence for demographic research.

Short-listed candidates will be called for an interview.

Terms of employment

The position covers four years of full time study with wages according to regulations for doctoral student positions.
