Assistant/Associate Faculty Positions in Health Services Research, Department of Psychiatry

The UAMS Psychiatric Research Institute (PRI), Department of Psychiatry in Little Rock, Arkansas is seeking two PhD investigators for the Division of Health Services Research (DHSR) at the level of Assistant or Associate Professor. This will be a full-time, non-tenure or tenure track position. The position reports directly to the Director of DHSR. Combining research, education and clinical services into one state-of-the-art facility, the UAMS Psychiatric Research Institute (PRI) serves as the epicenter for UAMS Psychiatry and is the only one of its kind in Arkansas. With its tall glass façade and naturally lighted atrium, PRI is a modern monument to those who helped create it and those who continue to serve it as they examine causes of and treatment for mental illness and substance abuse. The five-story, 110,000 square-foot building offers inpatient and outpatient services, with 40 beds dedicated to psychiatric patients.

The mission of DHSR is to improve the lives of individuals with mental health and substance abuse use disorders by conducting scientifically rigorous research in close partnership with clinical and community stakeholders. DHSR is looking for experienced investigators who will work with highly motivated staff to expand its portfolio of federally funded research.

The successful candidate will have the ability or potential to effectively lead research teams and to collaborate with investigators across a wide range of disciplines. An active program of scholarship and publication is essential. For more senior scholars a track record of externally funded research and for more junior scholars, clear potential and prospects for attracting extramural funding are important. Two full-time, non-tenure or tenure-track positions are available and include the opportunity for a joint appointment within our VA-funded research centers. Faculty rank and compensation will be commiserate with experience. All inquiries will be handled in strict confidence and should be accompanied by a CV and a letter of inquiry.
