TENURE-TRACK ASSOCIATE & ASSISTANT PROFESSOR (2) OPENINGS

FIU's Robert Stempel College of Public Health and Social Work, is **seeking three colleagues** to fill tenure-track positions for the **School of Social Work**, one at the Associate Professor level and two at the Assistant Professor level. The Stempel College encourages and provides opportunities for multidisciplinary research collaborations and community-based research endeavors. According to 2015 released rankings of national universities by *Washington Monthly*, FIU placed 17th out of 279 higher education institutions (in terms of social mobility, research and service), up from 24th last year. The School of Social Work is a CSWE-accredited program with 500 students enrolled in our BSSW, MSW, and PhD programs. Our faculty are committed to excellence in research, teaching, and service, and have records of funded scholarship in a number of areas, including substance abuse, HIV/AIDS, gerontology, child welfare, and health disparities. The School of Social Work is also the home of two federally-supported research centers: The Center for Research on U.S. Latino HIV/AIDS and Drug Abuse (CRUSADA) and FIU-BRIDGE (a multidisciplinary prevention research institute devoted to the design, implementation, and evaluation of community-based prevention and brief intervention strategies for reducing risk behavior problems and enhancing wellbeing among youth).

Responsibilities: Successful candidates are expected to: maintain an active program of research through scholarly publications, external grant funding, and professional presentations; teach and mentor undergraduate, graduate and doctoral students; and participate in service activities.

Qualifications: Candidates must have a Ph.D. in Social Work or closely-related field and a record of scholarly publications. Preference will be given to candidates who have an MSW, two-years of post-MSW social work experience, and will advance our commitment to diversity. In addition:

- Candidates should demonstrate an established record of funded research and scholarly publications with a clear plan for continuing their research agenda.
- Candidates with interest in contributing to our curriculum concentration in advanced clinical practice and social policy are strongly encouraged to apply.
- Candidates with complementary areas of expertise are encouraged to apply, though we are open to a variety of research areas.

Candidates will be requested to provide names and contact information for at least three references who will be contacted as determined by the search committee.
